LIKEWISE, after supper, he took the Cup; and when he had given + thanks, he gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of this; for

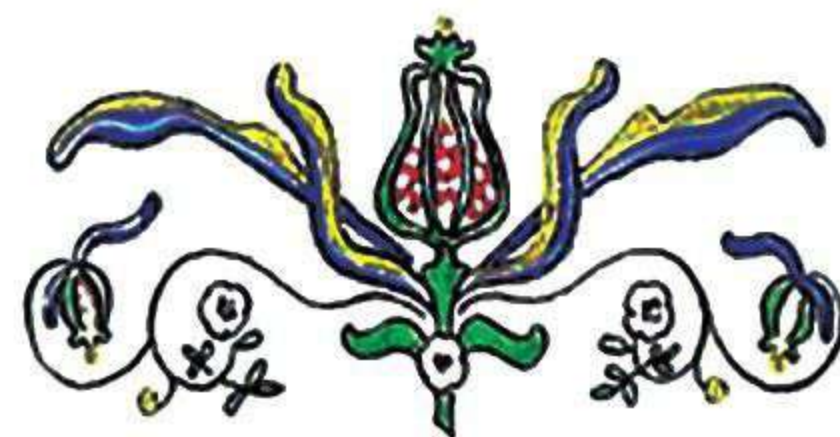
THIS IS MY BLOOD OF THE NEW TESTAMENT,

GRANT, O Lord, that what we have taken with our lips, we may receive with a pure heart; and that from a temporal gift it may become for us an eternal remedy.

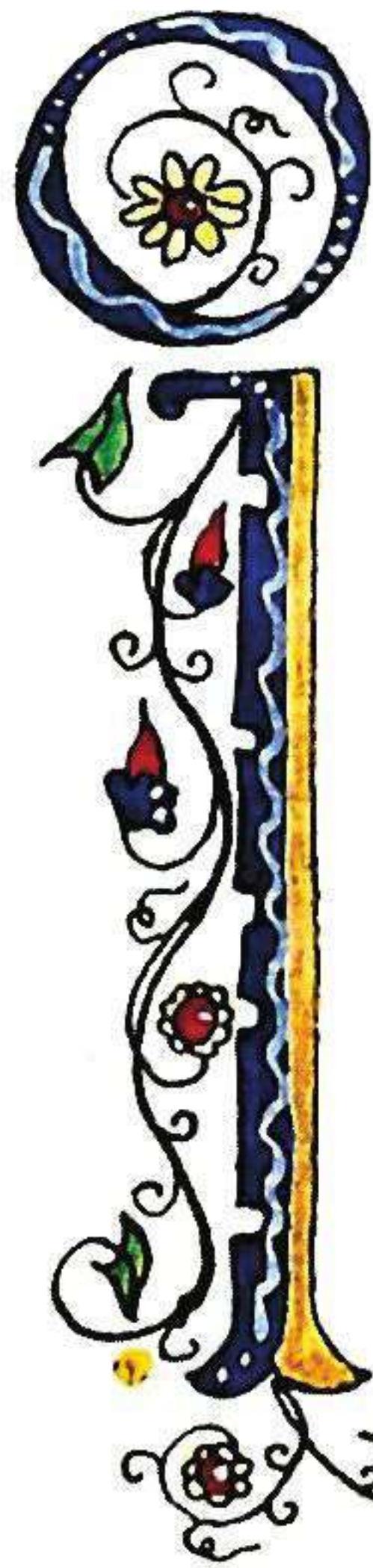
